KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-136

CLASSIFYING TRACT 1 AND TRACT 3, NIKISKI PARK SUBDIVISION AS PUBLIC USE LAND TO BE RETAINED FOR RECREATION USE, SOLID WASTE TRANSFER SITE, AND AS A SCHOOL SITE.

WHEREAS, portions of Tracts 1 and 2, Nikiski Park Subdivision are currently used by the North Kenai Peninsula Recreation Service Area for recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Tract 3, Nikiski Park Subdivision is currently used as a solid waste transfer site; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula School Board met on May 9, 1984 and approved the selection of Tract 1, Nikiski Park Subdivision as a site for a future middle school; and

WHEREAS, Tract 2 was classified as public use land by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly Resolution 82-152; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission met May 21, 1984 and unanimously recommended adoption of this Resolution;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Tract 1 and Tract 3, Nikiski Park Subdivision be classified as public use lands to be retained for recreational use, solid waste transfer site and as a school site.
