RESOLUTION 84-138

ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ROAD PRIORITIES UNDER THE LOCAL SERVICE ROAD AND TRAILS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to set forth procedures for the establishment of priorities for the construction of projects under the Local Service Roads and Trails program; and

WHEREAS, the previous procedures established under Resolution 77-26 are out of date; and

WHEREAS, the Public Affairs Committee of this Assembly has proposed the following procedures for establishment of such priorities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following procedures and guidelines shall govern, to the maximum extent feasible, the establishment of priorities for the letting of contracts for projects under the Local Service Roads and Trails Program.

I. Eligible Projects

- A. Gravel Collector Roads. Defined as providing access to a minimum of three subdivision groups, a minimum of twenty lots, and a minimum of ten inhabited dwellings.
- B. Other Projects. Any other project acceptable to the Department of Transportation under the Local Services Road and Trails program such as a foot-bridge or trail.

II. Establishing Priorities


- A. General Provisions. Priorities shall be established according to the greatest number of inhabited dwellings served by each individual project.
- B. Exceptions. A particular lower priority project may be elevated to a higher priority by the assembly if:
 - 1. All right-of-way issues have been resolved and the project is ready to bid; or
 - 2. The project involves a road providing access to local public facilities such as schools, fire stations, solid waste sites, etc.; or

3. The project involves a road identified by the administration as a major new arterial road; or
4. The cost of necessary relocation of utilities for a project of higher priority is found to be excessive; or
5. A number of school age children are in need of bus service.

Section 2. That Resolution 77-26 is repealed.


Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
