KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-14

REQUESTING INFORMATION FOR A FLOOD PLAIN DEVELOPMENT PLAN WHICH WOULD COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the assembly has not enacted a flood plain development management program and no borough land use regulations regarding development in flood plains are enforced currently within the borough; and

WHEREAS, the federal insurance administration which administers the national flood insurance program suspended all borough lands from participation in the flood insurance program until adequate flood plain land use regulations are enacted; and

WHEREAS, suspension of the borough from the flood insurance program for failure to enact land use measures resulted in withdrawal of federal flood insurance coverage from borough residents and the withdrawal of federal financial assistance for the acquisition or construction of buildings within the flood plain and of mortgage loans made by federally regulated lending institutions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is requested to prepare and submit for assembly consideration at the earliest feasible time information and preparation of a flood plain development control program which will satisfy the minimum mandatory requirements of the national flood insurance program.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
