KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-157

PROVIDING FOR NIKISKI AREA JUNIOR HIGH AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS.

WHEREAS, the current school district five year construction projections reflect plans for a junior high school facility in the Nikiski community for bond issue in 1985; and

WHEREAS, Nikiski area high school students are currently bussed as far as 35 miles one way to attend classes at Kenai Central High School; and

WHEREAS, Nikiski area high school students cannot participate in early bird classes due to the morning commuting distance to Kenai Central High School; and

WHEREAS, Nikiski area high school students are denied the opportunity to participate in after school academic and extra-curricular activities due to commuting distance; and

WHEREAS, as shown by the Seward and Homer High Schools, a medium size high school can definitely feature a very good curriculum; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a senior high school facility in Nikiski would alleviate the need for a planned 1985 addition to Kenai Central High School; and

WHEREAS, the enrollment projections meet the minimum as required by the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough School District plans reflected in the five year construction projections be revised to include plans for a Nikiski area junior high and senior high school.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
