GRANTING A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AND UTILITY EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH SELECTED LANDS.

WHEREAS, a request for a public right-of-way utility easement has been received for an existing road known as Easterday Road; and

WHEREAS, application for an easement for this road was applied for through the State of Alaska in 1962 and never formally completed; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has selected certain lands under the Municipal Entitlement Act including lands encompassing this proposed right-of-way easement and received working title to them; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission reviewed the request at its August 13, 1984 meeting and recommended the easement be granted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a public right-of-way and utility easement be granted for the existing road known locally as Easterday Road and described as follows:

Section 25, T5S, R14W, S.M., AK a 60' wide public right-of-way and utility easement centered on the east-west center line of said section.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents deemed necessary to effectuate this resolution and in the best interests of the Borough.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
