RESOLUTION 84-168

REQUESTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH PRIORITIES FOR BUDGETING AND CONSTRUCTION OF KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH'S HIGHWAYS AND ROADS.

WHEREAS, there are a significant number of state highways and roads in need of repair or reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous for the State Department of Transportation to establish priorities for an orderly development of the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Highway and road system; and


WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly wishes to express to State officials their advisory opinion on priorities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough Assembly adopts and endorses the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Advisory Highway and Road Capital Request as published by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Department of Public Works dated November 1984.

Section 2. That the Clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, to the Senate President, to the House Speaker, to Senators Paul Fisher and Jalmar Kerttula, and Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato & Mike Szymanski for the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
