RESOLUTION 84-172

A RESOLUTION OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY URGING THE GOVERNOR TO APPOINT A RESIDENT OF THE KENAI PENINSULA TO THE ALASKA RAILROAD MANAGEMENT BOARD.

WHEREAS, a sizable percentage of Alaska's population is centered within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, these same consumers are vitally interested in the success of the Alaska Railroad and its contribution to the welfare of the residents of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the southern terminus, the dock lease developments and the historical roots of the Alaska Railroad are located within the Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, the export of coal through the Port of Seward within the Kenai Peninsula Borough may well prove to be one of the main sources of revenue for the Alaska Railroad over the next fifteen years; and

WHEREAS, there are any number of business and civic minded individuals residing with the Kenai Peninsula Borough who would be well qualified and interested in participating in the sound management of the Alaska Railroad;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Governor of the State of Alaska is urged, should the opportunity present itself, to appoint a resident of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to the newly formed Alaska Railroad Management Board.


Section 2. That the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough provide a copy of this resolution to Governor William Sheffield.
