KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-173 (SUBSTITUTE)

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FOR APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN GRAVEL COLLECTOR ROADS.

WHEREAS, the main gravel collector roads within the Borough are currently maintained by the Borough's road service districts; and

WHEREAS, the majority of these roads serve areas of high population density and are in need of frequent maintenance; and

WHEREAS, The Borough Assembly finds that it is desirable to upgrade certain gravel collector roads so as to minimize the need for frequent maintenance due to high traffic volumes, and to provide better and more convenient access to the land lying along these main collectors; and

WHEREAS, the Road Maintenance Service Areas deem it advisable to submit a funding request at the earliest possible time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the State legislature be requested to provide for appropriations for the construction of certain gravel collector roads as published by the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Department of Public Works dated November 1984.

Section 2. That the Borough Assembly urges the State Legislature to appropriate the "full" construction funding request of \$8,380,000 for the list of roads identified in the Road Program Booklet.

Section 3. That the Clerk shall serve copies of this resolution upon Governor William J. Sheffield, to the Senate President, to the House Speaker, to Senators Paul Fischer and Jalmar Kerttula, and Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato and Mike Szymanski of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
