RESOLUTION 84-179

IN SUPPORT OF ROAD IMPROVEMENT TO EAST HILL ROAD, HOMER, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, East Hill Road located outside of Homer, Alaska is a State maintained unpaved secondary road with a 1983 daily traffic count of 980; and

WHEREAS, East Hill Road becomes impassable during breakup each spring due to its present gravel construction; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the assembly that upgrading of East Hill Road to paved construction by the State should be encouraged; and

WHEREAS, as a State maintained road, State capital funding for paving of East Hill Road must be approved by the Alaska legislature;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Governor of the State of Alaska and the State Legislature are hereby requested to propose and approve State capital funding for the paving of East Hill Road in the Kenai Peninsula Borough near Homer, Alaska.


Section 2. That the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough shall provide a copy of the resolution to Governor William Sheffield, to the Commissioner of the State Department of Transportation, and to the Kenai Peninsula delegation to the State legislature.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
