IN SUPPORT OF PLACING RELOCATION OF KBBI BROADCASTING FACILITIES  
IN FIRST PRIORITY IN THE ABC LIST OF PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, KBBI, Inc. is a nonprofit membership corporation  
which operates KBBI Radio Station serving the southern Kenai  
Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, KBBI has provided a wide variety of program ser-  
vices, particularly local news and information which is important  
to the community; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to relocate the facilities to a  
permanent site in the near future; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission has set  
priorities for funding of public broadcasting facilities in the  
state, and KBBI has received the highest priority; and


WHEREAS, a grant that would be administered by the Alaska  
Public Broadcasting Commission is needed to fund this project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly  
requests that the relocation of the KBBI broadcasting facilities  
be placed in first priority in the Alaska Public Broadcasting  
Commission's list of projects.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately

Sheffield, Lieutenant Governor Stephen McAlpine, Senator Paul  
Fisher and Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, and Betty  
Cato, and a copy to the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission.
