RESOLUTION 84-181

SUPPORTING THE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION OF THE PRATT MUSEUM.

WHEREAS, the Pratt Museum has long provided the residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough with an informative, educational display of natural and cultural objects of Alaska's history; and

WHEREAS, the proposed renovation/expansion of the Pratt Museum will greatly increase the museum's ability to exhibit its collections and to make research collections available for use by students and scholars through improved facilities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed expansion will for the first time provide access to all areas of the museum by the handicapped and elderly; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough Assembly to express its support for the 1984-85 financing plan of the Society in order to assist the Society in acquiring funds from the federal government, State of Alaska and the private sector;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly supports the proposed renovation/expansion plan for the Pratt Museum and urges support of the federal government, State of Alaska and the private sector in funding for that renovation.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is requested to provide a copy of this resolution to U.S. Senators, Congressmen, Governor William Sheffield and Peninsula Representatives to the State Legislature.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
