Resolution 84-183

OPPOSITION TO ESTABLISHMENT OF A JUVENILE SEX OFFENDER FACILITY ON THE KENAI PENINSULA.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly has received information that the State is planning to establish a juvenile sex offender facility on the Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, there are several various incarceration facilities for criminal offenders presently located or under construction within the peninsula; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the assembly that the Kenai Peninsula Borough presently shoulders more than its full share of such incarceration facilities of the State; and

WHEREAS, the assembly believes that location of a juvenile sex offender facility on the Kenai Peninsula would be an inappropriate burden in that there is no established need for such a facility for residents of the Kenai Peninsula;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Governor of the State of Alaska and the Kenai Peninsula Representatives in the State Senate and House are hereby notified of the opposition of the assembly to the establishment of a juvenile sex offender facility within the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough shall provide a copy of this resolution to Governor William Sheffield, and to the peninsula representatives in the State House and Senate.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
