RESOLUTION 84-185

REQUESTING APPROPRIATION BY THE LEGISLATURE FOR A \$550,000 GRANT TO THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND EQUIPMENT ACQUISITION.

WHEREAS, Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area was approved by its voters in October of 1983; and

WHEREAS, the service area became operational on July 1, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the total revenues from the tax levy for the service area are approximately \$89,000; and

WHEREAS, this new service area is in need of a fire station and equipment so that it may serve the people of the community; and

WHEREAS, all existing equipment has been transferred from the old Anchor Point Volunteer Fire Department;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the State of Alaska is requested to provide a grant to the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Service Area in the amount of \$550,000 to be utilized as follows:


1. Land acquisition for a new station - \$50,000
2. Design and construction of a station facility - \$350,000
3. Purchase of a fire truck and other equipment for the service area - \$150,000

Section 2. That copies of this resolution shall be sent to Governor William Sheffield, Lieutenant Governor Steven McAlpine, Department of Community & Regional Affairs, and all Senators and Representatives of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
