CERTIFYING THE RESULTS OF THE OCTOBER 23, 1984 RUNOFF ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Canvassing Board of the Kenai Peninsula Borough met on October 29, 1984 and tallied the votes of Questioned and Absentee ballots together with votes counted on election night; and

WHEREAS, the final results of the Runoff Election as recorded by the Canvass Board are as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

1. That Stanley F. Thompson received 4,484 votes in the Runoff Election and is elected to a three year term as Borough Mayor.

2. That in Assembly District 2, the Seat A vacancy, Francis S. Moore received 1,488 votes in the Runoff Election and is elected to a three year term on the Assembly.

3. That in Assembly District 2, the Seat E vacancy, Frank Mullen received 1,392 votes in the Runoff Election and is elected to a three year term on the Assembly.
