Resolution 84-19

GRANTING AN EASEMENT TO THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA 25 FEET IN WIDTH ACROSS BOROUGH PATENTED LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A STORM SEWER.

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna has requested a storm sewer easement for the construction of a storm drainage system in conjunction with the widening of Redoubt Avenue; and

WHEREAS, such improvement to Redoubt Avenue will add to the safety of students at the Soldotna Junior High School and Redoubt Elementary School; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, at their meeting of December 19, 1983, recommended the granting of such easement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the grant of a storm sewer easement 25 feet in width running northerly along the westerly boundary of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, T5N, R10W, S.M. for 1270.5 feet containing 0.73 acres, more or less is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign the necessary documents to effectuate such easement.
