KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-190

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATIONS FOR LAND ACQUISITION AND THE CONSTRUCTION AND DESIGN OF A JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY IN KENAI.

WHEREAS, there is presently no juvenile detention facility in the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, juveniles detained for referral to the juvenile court must be transferred to Anchorage or held in rented motel rooms; and

WHEREAS, juvenile detentions are generally for a period of up to 48 hours or up to 30 days; and

WHEREAS, detentions for 1984 are anticipated to number 232; and

WHEREAS, detentions during the next five years are anticipated to increase to approximately 583 as included in the projections attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests the State Legislature to provide appropriations for the acquisition of land and for the construction and design of a juvenile detention facility for the Kenai Peninsula Borough to be located in the proximity of the Kenai Courthouse.


Section 2: That copies of this resolution be distributed to Governor Bill Sheffield, President of the Senate, Speaker of the House, the House and Senate Finance Committees and the Health, Education and Social Services Committee.

Section 3: That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
