KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-196

AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THAT PARCEL OF BOROUGH OWNED LAND COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE BEAVER CREEK SITE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CENTRAL PENINSULA INCINERATOR FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has authorized the development of the Hydrogeological/Geotechnical Investigation of the proposed incinerator site at Beaver Creek; and

WHEREAS, the results of that investigation indicate that the location of the incinerator at that site will not adversely impact surface and/or subsurface waters of the area; and

WHEREAS, the use of the site for the development of an incinerator would not directly impact any subdivisions or residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the location of the incinerator at this site is the most economical from the standpoint of electrical power tie-in costs and solid waste hauling costs; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Department of Public Works to locate the incinerator at this site;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a portion of the Borough owned land commonly referred to as the Beaver Creek Site be set aside as the location for the development of the Central Peninsula Incinerator Facility.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
