KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-197

REQUESTING THAT THE PORTION OF THE KENAI PENINSULA NORTH OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF T7N., S.M., AK.; WEST OF THE MOOSE RANGE BOUNDARY AND EAST OF COOK INLET OFFICIALLY BE ESTABLISHED AS NIKISKI.

WHEREAS, a popular vote election in 1964 named the area Port Nikiski; and

WHEREAS, in 1969 the North Kenai Fire Service Area was created; however, by popular vote in 1976 the name was changed to the Nikiski Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, in 1981 the assembly named the elementary school as the Nikiski Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 1983 the original petition for an official post office and zip code contained six hundred sixty-six (666) signatures in favor of Nikiski as the official name; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, November 6, 1984 an advisory ballot was overwhelmingly approved in favor of the name of Nikiski;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly acting as the official governmental body, requests that the official post office name for the above described area be changed to Nikiski and that a zip code be established to reflect the desires of the majority of the residents in the area.


Section 2. That the Department of Community and Regional Affairs and the Boundary Commission set in motion the formal proceedings to effect this name change.

Section 3. That the National Geological Survey Office, upon completion of all formal proceedings, adjust the area maps, current and future, to reflect the name of Nikiski.

Section 4. That the clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Governor William Sheffield; Emil Notti, Commissioner of Community and Regional Affairs; Postmaster Opinsky; Offices of the Boundary Commission and Geological Survey; to Senators Paul Fischer, Jalmar Kerttula, and Edna Armstrong; and to Representatives Mike Navarre, Andre Marrou, Bette Cato and Mike Szymanski.

Section 5. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
