RESOLUTION 84-209

DECLARING THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH IMPROPERLY APPORTIONED.

WHEREAS, in September of 1983, a special census was conducted within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the results of that census show that the existing Assembly districts are not equally apportioned with some districts being over-represented on the Assembly, and some under-represented; and


WHEREAS, the Assembly concludes that the variances in representation are so great as to constitute an improperly apportioned Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby declares that it is improperly apportioned, and that a new plan for reapportionment of Borough Assembly seats and/or districts be prepared.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
