RESOLUTION 84-21

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH COLE-THOMPSON ARCHITECTS FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION OF THE HOMER HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to design and construct a new Homer Highway Maintenance Facility to obtain State property for the Homer High School; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has negotiated with the Borough for the construction of the new Maintenance Facility using the McGrath Airport Vehicle Shop as a model; and

WHEREAS, Cole-Thompson Architects designed the McGrath Airport Vehicle Shop; and

WHEREAS, there are certain cost savings associated with utilizing the same architect.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That authorization is given for an agreement with Cole-Thompson Architects to design and provide construction inspection services for the new Homer Highway Maintenance Facility in the amount of \$ 62,260.00. This shall be charged to the Homer Highway Maintenance Facility Acct. 062-11683-9015.

Section 2. That the mayor is authorized to execute such documents as are necessary and proper to enter the agreement.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
