RESOLUTION 84-28

REQUESTING THE STATE BOARD OF FISHERIES TO HOLD HEARINGS ON THE KENAI PENINSULA.

WHEREAS, the State Board of Fisheries will conduct hearings in March 1984; and

WHEREAS, such hearings will include, among other topics, hearings on regulations and other matters concerning the upper Cook Inlet fisheries; and


WHEREAS, the fisheries of the upper Cook Inlet are a vital industry to the Kenai Peninsula, and those that are most vitally affected should be afforded the opportunity to participate fully in the portions of the hearings pertaining to the upper Cook Inlet fisheries;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the State Board of Fisheries is hereby requested to hold its hearings, scheduled for March 1984, at some location on the Kenai Peninsula, or alternatively, to hold such portions of the hearings as pertains to the upper Cook Inlet fisheries at a location on the Kenai Peninsula.

Section 2. That the Borough Clerk shall send copies of this resolution to the Honorable William J. Sheffield, Governor of the State of Alaska, to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, to members of the House of Representatives Milo Fritz, Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, and Vern Hurlbert, and to all members of the State Board of Fisheries.
