RESOLUTION 84-44

ENDORSEMENT BY THE ASSEMBLY OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AREA FOR FUNDS FOR PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE FIGHTING FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area has made application, or is in the process of making application, for grant funds for the purchase of land, fire fighting equipment and related facilities; and

WHEREAS, the board of directors of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area has enacted its resolution requesting assembly endorsement of this application; and

WHEREAS, the application is for \$150,000 for the fire truck and fire equipment and \$300,000 for land purchase and construction of a fire station; and

WHEREAS, the assembly deems it in the best interest of the borough and service area to endorse such request so that funds may be obtained for such purchases;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly hereby endorses the application for \$450,000 in grant funds from the State of Alaska for the purchase of one (1) fire truck, fire equipment and the purchase of land for and construction of one (1) fire station.

Section 2. That to the extent that funds are not yet appropriated for such grant programs the assembly urges the legislature to appropriate grant funds so that this application may be funded.

Section 3. That the clerk shall submit a copy of this resolution to the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area board for submission to the appropriate state agencies for use in processing the grant application.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Alaska is considering legislation which makes special appropriations for the purchase of fire fighting equipment and construction of fire fighting facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area Board should request an appropriation or grant through the State of Alaska for needed fire fighting equipment and related facilities;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

That the Board of Directors of the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area requests the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to adopt a resolution requesting a special appropriation or grant for the purchase of fire fighting equipment and related facilities as follows:


Purchase one (1) Fire truck and fire equipment \$150,000

Construction of one (1) Fire Station and Land purchase \$300,000

Total \$450,000.

That the Assembly is further requested to adopt and submit to the First Session, Fifteenth Legislature of the State of Alaska, a request for funds to purchase this equipment, by grant or special appropriation, and such resolution shall be submitted through the legislative delegation for the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-45

PROVIDING FOR A MORATORIUM ON ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS, PROCESSING, OR APPROVAL OF SUBDIVISIONS INVOLVING SUBSTANDARD LOT SIZES WHERE THE SUBDIVISIONS ARE PROPOSED FOR THE PURPOSES OF RECREATIONAL USE.

WHEREAS, no current ordinance exists for the subdivision of properties for high density recreational use; and

WHEREAS, such recreational subdivisions are primarily in the river recreational areas of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, problems have been experienced with the procedures of allowing such subdivisions by exception, and such procedures are inadequate to properly handle such subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, any actions to be taken by the Kenai Peninsula Borough in establishing regulations or conditions for such high density recreational subdivision use will be dependent, in part, upon plans that will be established by the State of Alaska in connection with the Kenai River Management Plans; and


WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary by this Assembly to provide a moratorium on acceptance or processing, or approval of any high density recreational subdivisions that involve lots of substandard size for the purposes of waste disposal or other lot size requirements under the Borough ordinances;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That for a period of one year from the date of adoption of this resolution, no applications shall be accepted and processed, and no exception or approval shall be granted for any subdivision which is proposed for the purpose of providing recreational use lots where the subdivision would result in the substandard lot size that is not capable of meeting the standards for disposal of waste materials imposed by the Department of Environmental Conservation of the State of Alaska, or that would result in high density use such as would require a special exception to the existing ordinances of the Borough, or to existing statutes of the State of Alaska, and any regulations adopted pursuant to those ordinances and statutes.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately on the date of its adoption.
