KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-48

REQUESTING THE MAYOR TO FILE SUIT ON BEHALF OF THE BOROUGH TO STOP IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN CURRENTLY PROPOSED BY THE GOVERNOR.

WHEREAS, the Reapportionment Board of the State of Alaska has made its recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Alaska is considering adoption of the Reapportionment Plan; and

WHEREAS, plans under consideration for implementation would combine areas of the Borough into election districts with which the Borough areas have no common geographic, economic, or social interests; and



WHEREAS, such redistricting would appear to violate the requirements of the Alaska Constitution regarding reapportionment;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby requested to initiate action and file suit on behalf of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to set aside any reapportionment plan that redistricts the Borough in such a way that Borough areas are combined with areas with which they have no geographic, political, social, or economic common interests.

Section 2. Alternatively, the Mayor is requested to join in or assist in any suits brought by individuals or groups to challenge or set aside such reapportionment plans.
