RESOLUTION 84-50

SUPPORTING SB 389 FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF MONEY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A KENAI RIVER BRIDGE WHICH WOULD PROVIDE ACCESS TO FUNNY RIVER ROAD.

WHEREAS, SB 389 has been introduced to the Legislature by Senators Gilman and Fischer for the construction of a Kenai River bridge providing access to Funny River Road; and

WHEREAS, such bridge would provide needed access and be of great benefit to the Borough; and


WHEREAS, this bridge would provide a more orderly means of access to the river and development of property, which would enhance the ability to protect the river and its resources;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the Borough supports and urges the passage of SB 389 to provide for the construction of a Kenai River bridge that would provide access to the Funny River Road area.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Borough shall distribute copies of this resolution to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, and to Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz, and Vern Hurlbert.
