RESOLUTION 84-57

REQUESTING THE STATE LEGISLATURE TO ADOPT HOUSE COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE HB 172 AS AMENDED THAT WOULD CLARIFY AND UPDATE TITLE 29

WHEREAS, HB 172 has been in committee since it was introduced in the first session of the 13th Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the House C&RA Committee held public hearings and as a result, recommended some minor amendments embodied in a Committee Substitute; and

WHEREAS, it is a bill that is in the best interests of municipalities, both large and small, to get an updated statute on the books; and

WHEREAS, passage of bills dealing with the update and clarification of Title 29 is one of the top priorities of the Alaska Municipal League; and

WHEREAS, this particular legislation has been in the making for a number of years and any further consideration of amendments or reopening of consideration of amendments could jeopardize an updated version of Title 29 being put in place; and

WHEREAS, we support the adoption of the proposed House C&RA Amended Committee Substitute without further amendments;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Legislature of the State of Alaska and the Governor of the State of Alaska are hereby requested to enact and sign the legislation which would adopt the updated and clarified Title 29 and thereby give guidance to the municipalities.


Section 2. The Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough will distribute copies of this resolution to Governor William Sheffield, Senate President Jalmar Kerttula, House Speaker Joe Hayes, Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, Representatives Hugh Malone, Milo Fritz, Bette Cato and Vern Hurlbert.
