KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-58

RECOMMENDING CHANGES TO SENATE BILL 417 SUBSTITUTE TO INCLUDE THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH IN THE DECISION MAKING PROCESS.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 417 (Committee Substitute) has been introduced regarding a comprehensive management plan for the Kenai River; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the bill is to include local participation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby resolves that language be added to certain sections of Senate Bill 417 (Committee Substitute) so that the participation of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is insured in the development of the comprehensive management plan. The sections should read, with the recommended added language shown as underlined, as follows:

Sec. 41.21.506. COMPREHENSIVE MANAGEMENT PLAN; REGULATIONS. (a) Within two years after the effective date of this Act the commissioner and the Kenai Peninsula Borough shall develop and adopt a comprehensive management plan for the Kenai River Special Management Area. The plan may cover the land abutting the rivers described in AS 41.21.502(a)(1) - (3) whether state-owned or privately owned. The commissioner and the Kenai Peninsula Borough may periodically review the plan and adopt changes to the plan as conditions warrant.

Sec. 41.21.510. PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT. In developing and implementing the management plan required by AS 41.21.506(a), the commissioner and the Kenai Peninsula Borough shall...

Sec. 41.21.512. COOPERATIVE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENTS. The commissioner jointly with any municipalities affected may enter into cooperative management agreements with federal agencies, municipalities, other state agencies, or private landowners to effectuate the proposes of this Act.

Section 2. That the Clerk shall serve copies of this resolution upon The Honorable William Sheffield, Governor of Alaska; Senators Donald Gilman, Paul Fischer, Richard Eliason and Bob Mulcahy; Representative Milo Fritz and the Senate Fisheries Committee.
