KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-65

AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF BOROUGH LANDS TO THE CITY OF SEWARD FOR USE AS A PRISON SITE.

WHEREAS, The City of Seward wishes to provide a site for construction of a State Prison Facility within it's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City needs additional lands to provide the site; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has lands that could be made available for the Prison Site; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission has recommended making Sections 17 & 18, T. 1S., R. 1E., S.M. available for the Prison Site; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly deems it in the best interests of the Borough to deed this land to the City of Seward for the specific use as a Prison Site.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The Borough Assembly hereby authorizes the Mayor to transfer to the City of Seward the 225 acres within Section 17 & 18, T. 1S., R. 1E., S.M. needed for the State Prison Site. Upon such terms and conditions as are agreed upon by the Borough Administration and the City of Seward, including a reversionary clause or such other provisions to protect the interest of the Borough.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized, upon assembly approval, to execute all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.

Section 3. This resolution takes effect immediately.
