KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-67

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PORT GRAHAM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO COLLINS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,062,800 PENDING THE SALE AND DELIVERY OF 1983 SCHOOL BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Borough has solicited and opened bids for the construction of the Port Graham Elementary School project; and

WHEREAS, architectural documents have been approved by the Borough by Resolution Nos. 83-129; 83-160; and 84-17; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds will be available upon sale and delivery of the 1983 bonds for this project, and the Public Works Department has recommended that the contract be awarded;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the bid of Collins Construction Company to perform all work required by the Port Graham Elementary School project for the base bid sum of \$1,040,000 plus Alternate 1 of \$22,800 is accepted; and that a contract for this work inclusive of Alternate 1 in the total amount of \$1,062,800 is authorized. All expenditures for this work shall be charged to the Port Graham Elementary School Account.

Section 2. That the award of this contract is contingent upon the sale of the 1983 school bonds; this contract shall not become effective and no Notice to Proceed shall be issued until these bonds have been sold and delivered.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption, and that the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents necessary to carry out this resolution.
