RESOLUTION 84-72

IN SUPPORT OF, AND URGING THE ADOPTION OF COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL 417.

WHEREAS, the Senate Resources Committee has adopted a committee substitute for Senate Bill 417 originally introduced by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, this committee substitute is accompanied by a letter of intent also adopted by the Senate Resources Committee; and

WHEREAS, this committee substitute provides for involvement in the Kenai Peninsula Borough which is vitally effected by the bill creating a Kenai River special management area; and


WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough feels that the committee substitute should be adopted by the legislature in the form recommended by the Senate Resources Committee;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby supports and urges the passage of the committee substitute for Senate Bill 417, as adopted by the committee without change, and, further, that the legislature adopt as its own intent, the letter of intent adopted by the committee in connection with the intent and purpose of the committee substitute for Senate Bill 417.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
