RESOLUTION 84-87

GRANTING AN EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH LANDS TO HOMER ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION TO INSTALL UNDERGROUND LINES NEAR SOLDOTNA JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Homer Electric Association has applied for an easement to relocate existing overhead electric transmission lines by replacing with underground lines because of the reconstruction of Redoubt Avenue, Soldotna;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

Section 1. That a utility right-of-way easement be granted to Homer Electric Association across SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 30, T5N, R10W, S.M. more particularly described as a strip of land 10 feet in width the centerline of which is 45 feet north of the northerly right-of-way line of Redoubt Avenue and extending westerly 440 feet more or less from the easterly line of said SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$, Section 30, T5N, R10W, S.M.

Section 2. That a condition of this grant is that Homer Electric Association will schedule construction to coordinate with the City of Soldotna and its contractors who will be installing a sewer lift station at this location during this construction season.


Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to sign the necessary easement document(s).
