KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 84-89 (AMENDED)

URGING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION TO MAINTAIN THE BEST AVAILABLE POLLUTION CONTROL TECHNOLOGY AS THE STANDARD WITHIN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Environmental Conservation, presently has the sole responsibility for regulation of industrial emissions into the atmosphere within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, minimizing atmospheric industrial emission is in the best interest of residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and


WHEREAS, The use of any pollution control equipment less than the best available control technology is unacceptable to the residents of the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation insure that levels of chemical discharge into the air are kept at the minimum level that technology will permit. It is further resolved that ADEC is requested to review and update emission level standards so that emissions are at the minimal level consistent with technology available at the time of such review.

Section 2. That a copy of this resolution shall be submitted to Commissioner Richard Neve', Department of Environmental Conservation; to the Regional Director of the Environmental Protection Agency and to Governor Bill Sheffield; Senators Donald E. Gilman and Paul Fischer; and Representatives Hugh Malone, Milo Fritz and Bette M. Cato.
