RESOLUTION 84-91

REQUESTING A GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS, RURAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM TO PURCHASE ONE TANKER TRUCK FOR THE RIDGEWAY FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Rural Development Assistance Grant Program administered through the Department of Community & Regional Affairs provides for special grants for public service requirements including fire fighting equipment; and

WHEREAS, the board of directors of the Ridgeway Fire Service Area has adopted Resolution 5-02-84 requesting the assembly to adopt a resolution requesting a special grant appropriation; and


WHEREAS, the assembly finds that the request of the Ridgeway Fire Service Area deserves favorable consideration by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly requests a special grant from the rural development assistance grant program administered by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for the acquisition of one tanker truck in an amount of \$100,000 to be used in the performance of fire protection services by the Ridgeway Fire Service Area. This resolution authorizes the actions necessary to apply for this grant.

Section 2. That a copy of this resolution shall be submitted to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs and to Governor Bill Sheffield, Senate President Jalmar M. Kerttula; House Speaker Joe L. Hayes; Senators Donald E. Gilman and Paul Fischer; and Representatives Hugh Malone, Milo Fritz and Bette M. Cato.
