RESOLUTION 84-92

APPROVING UP TO FIVE ASSEMBLY MEMBERS TO ATTEND THE FORTY-NINTH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES AND DESIGNATING THE DELEGATE AND ALTERNATE TO VOTE FOR THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is a member of the National Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, several members of the Borough Assembly are presently serving on boards or committees of the National Association of Counties; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties annual meeting provides an opportunity for the Kenai Peninsula Borough to make its voice heard in matters affecting local officials nationwide;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly president hereby authorizes up to five assembly members to attend the National Association of Counties 1984 49th Annual Conference to be held in Seattle, Washington, July 7 through July 10, 1984.


Section 2. That the assembly president shall designate the Kenai Peninsula Borough's voting delegate and the alternate delegate.
