KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-98

AUTHORIZING ROY F. WESTON, INC. TO PROCEED WITH PHASE II OF THE CENTRAL PENINSULA SOLID WASTE INCINERATION PROJECT AT A COST OF \$90,000.00.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough exercises Borough-wide Solid Waste disposal powers, and

WHEREAS, THE Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly has authorized Roy F. Weston, Inc. to prepare a report as to the feasibility of developing an Incineration Facility for the codisposal of solid waste and septage generated in the Central Peninsula Region of the Borough, and

WHEREAS, the results of that feasibility study have shown that incineration of Solid Waste and Septage when coupled with power generation is more economically feasible than the current practice of landfilling, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has recommended authorizing Roy F. Weston, Inc. to proceed with Phase II of the project, and

WHEREAS, that parcel of Borough owned/selected land known as the Beaver Creek Site has been identified as a potentially suitable site for the location of the Incineration Facility:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Roy F. Weston, Inc. is authorized to proceed with Phase II of the Central Peninsula Solid Waste Incineration Project which shall be comprised of the following tasks as outlined in the Roy F. Weston, Inc. proposal P84-1415 dated February 21, 1984:

1. Preparation of procurement bid documents
2. Determination of permit conditions and HEA contract terms
3. Alternative A - Evaluation of shallow and deep aquifers existing on Borough owned/selected property
4. Obtain subsurface soils information necessary for development of pre-construction bid documents

Section 2. That Phase II of the project shall not exceed the \$90,000 in Federal Revenue Sharing Funds set aside for this

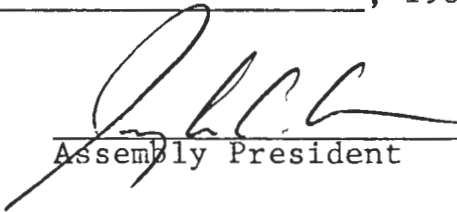
purpose in the 1984-85 fiscal year budget.

Section 3. That that portion of Borough owned/selected lands known as the Beaver Creek Site shall be evaluated for use as the location for the incinerator, provided that upon completion of the evaluation, all information pertaining to the site shall be presented to the Assembly for this review, and that the use of the site as a location for the incineration facility would then be subject to the approval of the Assembly.

Section 4. That this authorization to proceed is subject to appropriation of the funds specified in Section 2 of this resolution.


Section 5 That the Mayor is authorized to implement this Resolution immediately upon its adoption.
