RESOLUTION 85-1

APPROVING THE RECOMMENDATION FOR THE SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION, TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE PAUL BANKS BOND FUND CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FOR SCHEMATIC DESIGN SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH MCGLOTHLIN BALIVET CO. ARCHITECT.

WHEREAS, the School Board has identified the Soldotna Elementary School Project as a priority project; and

WHEREAS, the Paul Banks Elementary School Addition is substantially completed with approximately \$279,523 remaining in the contingency account; and

WHEREAS, the School Board is charged by Alaska Statute 14-140.060 (E) with determining design criteria for school buildings and with selecting the architect to develop these designs, subject to the approval of the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the School Board has reviewed numerous architectural firms for the 1985/86 Projects; and

WHEREAS, the School Board recommends McGlothlin Balivet architectural firm for the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

Section 1. That the School Board's recommendation of the Soldotna Elementary School Addition project is approved.

Section 2. That funds totaling \$76,000 are hereby transferred from the Paul Banks Elementary contingency account #401-720400-49999 to the Soldotna Elementary School Addition account #401-760100-49999 for schematic design and comprehensive cost projections, soils investigation and site surveying.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate a contract with McGlothlin Balivet architectural firm for professional services.


Section 4. That the architect, McGlothlin Balivet, is authorized to proceed with schematic design and cost projections at a cost not to exceed \$66,000.

Section 5. That the contract with the architect shall provide that the architect shall not have the right to proceed with the preparation of design development or subsequent phases without prior Assembly approval.


Section 6. That the Mayor is authorized to contract for soils investigation and site survey at an amount not to exceed \$10,000.

Section 7. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
