KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-3

RECOMMENDING GUIDELINES FOR USE BY THE CITIZENS' ADVISORY BOARD
IN MAKING PROPOSALS FOR PROTECTION OF THE KENAI RIVER RESOURCE.

WHEREAS, the borough intends to cooperate with the Division
of Parks in the development of a Kenai River Comprehensive
Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the borough realizes it may be advisable to include
lands along the Kenai River and its tributaries in the study to
protect the river and its resources;

WHEREAS, SB 417 provides that a comprehensive management
plan including private property can only be implemented by the
municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough reaffirms its under-
standing that any recommendations of the citizens' advisory board
come back to the Borough and cities for consideration and
approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the borough recommends that private and
public lands along the Kenai River be included in the study of
land use implications on the river's resources by the citizens'
advisory board.

Section 2. That the borough recommends no specific planning
boundaries at this time, but recommends that the citizens'
advisory board develop those parameters as a result of its
consideration of the Kenai River and its resource protection.

Section 3. That the Clerk shall send copies of this
resolution to Governor Bill Sheffield; Esther Wunnicke,
Commissioner of Natural Resources; Neil Johannsen, Director of
Parks; the citizens' advisory board chairman and the cities of
Kenai and Soldotna.
