RESOLUTION 85-9

OFFICIALLY DESIGNATING THE ROUTE OF THE IDITAROD NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL THROUGH THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Iditarod Trail has acquired national historic trail status; and

WHEREAS, the historical route of the Iditarod Trail originated in the city of Seward running north through the Kenai Peninsula Borough in its route to the city of Nome and the city of Seward has designated the route of the trail through the City of Seward; and


WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the concept of the Iditarod Trail as a national historic trail;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the route of the Iditarod Trail is officially designated continuing from the corporate city limits of the city of Seward running north on the Seward Highway to its intersection with Nash Road; then along Nash Road for approximately three miles to the intersection with Sawmill Creek. At this point the trail will extend northward through State, National Forest, and Borough lands before exiting from the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
