RESOLUTION 85-107

SUPPORTING A RURAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS FOR MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR THE HOMER VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.

WHEREAS, the Homer Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. is a nonprofit corporation which provides fire protection services to Borough residents both within the cities of Homer and Kachemak and in the surrounding areas outside of those cities; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. is in need of a new tanker-pumper truck to replace the 1964 tanker presently in use; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. has applied to the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Regional Affairs, Municipal and Regional Assistance Division, for a Rural Development Assistance Grant in the sum of \$100,000 for use as matching funding in purchase of a \$200,000 fully equipped tanker-pumper; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly supports the great efforts and good work of the Homer Volunteer Fire Department in its provision of fire protection services to residents of the south peninsula area;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly strongly supports the approval of a Rural Development Assistance Grant in the sum of \$100,000 from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs, Municipal and Regional Assistance Division, as matching funds for the purchase of a new tanker-pumper truck by the Homer Volunteer Fire Department, Inc.

Section 2. That the clerk is directed to send copies of this resolution to the Municipal and Regional Assistance Division of the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
