KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-112

DECLARING THE LOG BUILDING ON THE PORTION OF E $\frac{1}{2}$  W $\frac{1}{2}$  E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  LYING SOUTH OF ROAD, SECTION 31, T4S, R14W S.M., IS SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, a log building located on a portion of E $\frac{1}{2}$  W $\frac{1}{2}$  E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  lying South of road, Section 31, T4S, R14W S.M. was acquired under right-of-way acquisition of North Anchor River Road Phase II; and

WHEREAS, there has been an expressed interest in relocating the building elsewhere by Borough residents; and


WHEREAS, the log building is of no practical use to the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the log building located on a portion of E $\frac{1}{2}$  W $\frac{1}{2}$  E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  lying South of road, Section 31, T4S, R14W S.M. on North Anchor River Road is surplus to the needs of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. That the Administration is authorized to dispose of the log building through normal bid procedures.
