APPROVING EXPENDITURES OF \$5,800 FOR ROADSIDE LITTER CLEAN UP IN THE CENTRAL PENINSULA AREA.

WHEREAS, the annual voluntary highway litter clean-up program carried out in the Spring of 1985 was unable to remove significant amounts of litter from public areas due to the unusually late melt-off of snow and ice; and

WHEREAS, the belated arrival of the summer season has resulted in the appearance of large amounts of litter in public areas throughout the central peninsula area; and

WHEREAS, it is clearly in the public interest to accomplish the clean-up of accumulated litter from these public areas;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to expend funds not to exceed \$5,800 to accomplish a clean-up of litter in public areas in the central peninsula area outside of cities. Funding is to be accomplished as follows:

- A. For fiscal year 1984-85, \$2,000 from Acct. No. 100-311010-40120 (Public Works Administration-Part Time Wages);
- B. For fiscal year 1985-86, \$3,800 from Acct. No. 100-111010-49999 (Assembly Contingency Account) is transferred to Acct. No. 100-311010-40120 for this purpose.

Section 2. That Tim Wisniewski, Marge Mullen and Sharon Wik, community coordinators of the annual Spring volunteer clean-up, shall be consulted to direct this clean-up effort to specific areas of greatest need.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
