RESOLUTION 85-12

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PROCEED WITH THE PURCHASE OF A BURROUGHS A9F COMPUTER WITH PERIPHERALS, INITIAL EXPENSES AND CONVERSION COSTS OF \$1.6 MILLION AND HIRING OF TWO ADDITIONAL PROGRAMMER ANALYSTS.

WHEREAS, the present data processing system is inadequate to handle the borough's data processing needs; and

WHEREAS, the continued rapid expansion of data necessary for administration of the borough has required continual additions to the borough data processing facilities; and

WHEREAS, the staff recommends the purchase of a Burroughs A9F computer with peripherals, training and conversion costs of \$1.6 million; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Price Waterhouse has analyzed the staff recommendations for purchase of the Burroughs' system and concurred therewith; and

WHEREAS, two (2) additional programmer analysts are needed immediately by the data processing department; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENIN-SULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to hire two (2) additional programmer analysts.
- Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with the purchase of the Burroughs A9F computer peripherals, training and conversion costs which will add approximately \$1.5 million to the fiscal 1986 budget. \$100,000 for initial expenses is included in the fiscal 1985 budget.
- Section 3. That for other than certification purposes, the new computer shall be activated in stages approved by the data processing steering committee after development of the implementation plan.
- Section 4. That this resolution takes effect upon completion by the administration of a detailed conversion plan.
