ALLOCATING A BUDGET OF \$150,000.00 FOR HOLLEY-BECK STREET FROM L.S.R.T. FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Holley-Beck Street provides access to the new proposed Nikiski High School; and

WHEREAS, providing a state maintained access to the new school is of importance to the community; and

WHEREAS, the L.S.R.T. program is the only program which allows the Borough to upgrade Borough roads; and

WHEREAS, the upgrading of Holley-Beck Street to provide access to the new proposed school represents the Borough's highest L.S.R.T. priority; and

WHEREAS, the designs of Greer Road and Beaver Creek are complete and there are excess design funds in their accounts; and

WHEREAS, there are surplus contingency funds in the Brown's Lake Road account;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
