KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-128

GRANTING A 30 FOOT WIDE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY ACROSS BOROUGH PATENTED LANDS WITHIN SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, SEWARD MERIDIAN TO MATCH A 30 FOOT WIDE DEDICATED RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS BEAR ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Borough has patent to certain lands lying adjacent to a 30 foot wide half right-of-way dedication named Bear Road; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been contacted by some of the residents who utilize Bear Road and they have requested that 30 feet of right-of-way be granted in order to obtain a full dedication; and


WHEREAS, should the Borough ever dispose of these lands this 30 feet would be reserved in order to match the previously dedicated 30 feet;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a right-of-way described as being the north 30 feet of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 2, T5N, R8W, S.M., Alaska, to be known as Bear Road, is hereby granted for public use for road purposes.

Section 2. That the mayor is authorized to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate this resolution and deemed to be in the best interests of the Borough.
