KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-130

PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO ACQUIRE THE AREAWIDE POWER TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS WITHIN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the Borough does not currently have authority to expend tax revenues for senior citizen programs; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of such additional authority requires approval of the voters of the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That there shall be placed on the ballot at the next regular election the following proposition:

PROPOSITION:

"Shall the Kenai Peninsula Borough have the areawide power to provide for grant funding for operations and programs of senior citizens organizations located within the borough?"

Section 2. That upon approval by the voters, the assembly shall adopt or enact measures to implement this authority.
