APPROVING THE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT DOCUMENTS FOR THE SOLDOTNA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PREPARED BY ARCHITECT MCGLOTHLIN BALIVET.

WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula School Board recommends approval of design development document for the Soldotna Elementary School; and

WHEREAS the Assembly has previously approved Resolution 85-82 for the preparation of design development documents for the Soldotna Elementary School by architect, McGlothlin Balivet; and

WHEREAS, Assembly approval of architectural design development documents and comprehensive cost for the Soldotna Elementary School Project is required prior to placing on the October 1985 school bond ballot;



Section 1. That the design development documents for the Soldotna Elementary School project prepared by McGlothlin Balivet architects are approved together with the design development statement of probable costs as follows:
