RESOLUTION 85-137

APPROVING THE PROTOTYPE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT DOCUMENTS FOR THE NEW CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOL AND THE NEW NIKISKI HIGH SCHOOL AS PREPARED BY ARCHITECT MAYNARD & PARTCH.

WHEREAS, The Kenai Peninsula School Board recommends approval of prototype design development document for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has previously approved Resolution 85-84 for the preparation of prototype design development documents for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools by architect, Maynard & Partch; and

WHEREAS, Assembly approval of architectural design development documents and comprehensive cost for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools Projects is required prior to placing on the October 1985 school bond ballot;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

Section 1. That design development prototype documents for the new Central Peninsula and Nikiski High Schools projects, prepared by Maynard & Partch architects, are approved together with a design development statement of probable cost as follows:

New Central Peninsula High	\$21,567,000	\$28,215,000
New Nikiski High	\$23,450,000	\$30,240,000

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
