STATING THE ASSEMBLY POSITION SUPPORTING PRIVATE PROPERTY RIGHTS IN CONNECTION WITH STUDIES OR PLANS CONCERNING THE KENAI RIVER MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, the people of the Kenai Peninsula Borough have great respect for private property rights; and

WHEREAS, there is deep concern among the private landowners of the Kenai River corridor that recent Borough action would, or could, harm or take away some of their private property rights without agreed upon compensation; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly hereby goes on record as strongly supporting private property rights.

Section 2. That the clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Governor Bill Sheffield, to the Commissioner of the Department of Resources, the Corps of Engineers, Kenai Peninsula city mayors, to the Chairman of the Kenai River Special Management Board, and to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
