PROVIDING FOR BALLOT PROPOSITIONS TO AUTHORIZE THE KALIFORNSKY FIRE SERVICE AREA TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES, AND SETTING A MILL LEVY LIMIT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF A FIVE-MEMBER BOARD

WHEREAS, on July 16, 1985, the Kenai Peninsula Borough assembly approved Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute) as amended establishing the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area to provide fire protection services and providing for an elected board; and

WHEREAS, KPB 16.04.060 requires that voters of the service area approve the exercise of the powers specified in Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute) before they may be exercised; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute) sets a 2 mill levy limit that takes effect only after approval by the voters of the service area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following propositions shall be placed before the voters residing within the boundaries of the proposed Kalifornsky Fire Service Area, to be voted upon at the next regular election on October 1, 1985:

Do you approve the exercise of fire protection services within the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area established by Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute)?

Do you approve of setting a mill levy limit of 2 mills for the operation of the Kalifornsky Fire Service Area?

Section 2. That at the same election there shall be elected a five-member Board of Directors to serve in the event the service area is approved, and for the purpose of such election, candidates shall file for specific seats designated A, B, C, D

and E, and the terms and qualifications for each of such seats shall be as follows:

- A. Three years for the initial term, and three years for subsequent terms;
- B. Three years for the initial term, and three years for subsequent terms;
- C. Two years for the initial term, and three years for subsequent terms;
- D. Two years for the initial term, and three years for subsequent terms;
- E. One year for the initial term, and three years for subsequent terms.

Section 3. That qualifications for candidates, voting and conduct of this election shall be in accordance with the provisions of Title 4 of the Borough Code and Ordinance 84-43 (Substitute).

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
