KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 85-144

PLACING A PROPOSITION ON THE BALLOT FOR OCTOBER 1, 1985, THAT PROVIDES FOR THE EXPANSION OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH PORT AND HARBOR POWERS TO ALLOW MANAGEMENT AND IMPROVEMENT FOR THE NINILCHIK HARBOR.

WHEREAS, there is a continuing need for management as well as improvement at the Ninilchik Harbor; and

WHEREAS, over the years there has been overcrowding in the harbor to the point of a safety hazard and the harbor serves far more boats during the height of the season than it was designed for; and

WHEREAS, the borough port and harbor powers do not allow expenditure of capital funds or hiring of employees; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska did appropriate \$100,000 for management and improvement of the harbor during the Second Session of the Thirteenth General Assembly of the Alaska Legislature; and

WHEREAS, if empowered by the voters the borough could contract with an entity of the state or a private entity to manage the harbor as well as expend pass-through state funds for improvement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That an advisory proposition shall be placed upon the ballot of the next regular borough election, October 1, 1985, to be voted on by all registered outside city borough voters as follows:

Proposition:

"Shall the Kenai Peninsula Borough expand its port and harbor powers to allow for the expenditure of state grant funds for improvements to and management of the Ninilchik Harbor?"
