RESOLUTION 85-149

APPROVING THE TRANSFER OF \$44,000 FOR THE DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PHASES OF ARCHITECTURAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE NEW PROTOTYPE NIKISKI AND CENTRAL PENINSULA HIGH SCHOOLS FROM THE PAUL BANKS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly authorized architectural services for design development phase for 90,000 square feet high school facilities at Nikiski and Central Peninsula with Ordinance 85-19; and

WHEREAS, the size of the Nikiski high school facility has been increased from 90,000 square feet to 117,504 square feet and the Central Peninsula high school facility has been increased from 90,000 feet to 117,101 square feet; and

WHEREAS, the architect design development services are required to finalize the comprehensive cost for each of subject prototype projects.

WHEREAS, approximately \$52,000 remains in the Paul Banks project contingency account.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$44,000 is transferred from the Paul Banks project contingency account #401-720400-49999-83115 and assigned into the following project accounts for design development services:
